TEXT.

- 1. The paper is interesting, but it lacks the current previous study of the topics.
- 2. More clear on Conclusion. In conclusion you only need to explain about your result, no need to cite other references.
- 3. The authors also often violated the paper templates, the figure still has caption in bahasa, blurry images and dislocated table/figure. You need not to display capture images that are irrelevant to your study.
- 4. Do not insert source code captured, just use pseudocode.
- 5. Write the caption of your image.

Overall evaluation

TEXT:

In this research, it still has shortcomings under weaknesses that can be developed for subsequent research. Suggestions for future research are as follows:

- 1. Abstract must be containing: purpose of the research, method of the research, value/novelty and conclusion.
- 2. We usually expect a minimum of 20 to 30 references primarily to recent journal papers for research/original paper and review paper, respectively.
- 3. The presentation of results should be simple and straightforward in style. This section reports the most important findings, including results analyses as appropriate and comparisons to other research results. This section should be supported with suitable



references.

4. In this session the author has to explain all of the information related to this study. Remember, paper you made is not for the dummies, it means you need to explain what the main information you have to explain. The references used in the paper must be recent, accurate, and relevant to your topic. The authors are also suggested to follow proper citation techniques such as paraphrasing or quotation, if necessary. Please be careful with direct citations, which may lead to the act of plagiarism.
