CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the research finding, the researcher concluded literacy activities had the different significance on students' speaking ability at eighth grade students of SMP PAB 19 Manunggal. It meant that alternative hypotheses (H_a) was accepted. It can be seen from the statistical analysis that showed the t-test value (63.118) was higher than t-table (2.0322) and the (Sig.) value (0.000) was lower than 0,05. The used of literacy activities also helps increase students' self-confidence in speaking a topic/text, because practice becomes possible and this really helps students to learn in real learning. The statements is proven by the scores collected the experimental class is higher than the control class. And the t-test result greater than t table means there is a real difference between students who learn speaking by implemented literacy activities and students with conventional method. The findings of the research that students found it fun in using this learning technique, it helps the shy students and gived them more chances and opportunities to practice and enjoy speaking activities that can have an effect on speaking competence.

5.2 Suggestions

Based on the conclusion of the study, the researcher suggested that:

1. The english teachers can apply literacy activities to improve students' speaking ability. This activity creates good interaction between teacher and students, students and students and at the same time creating students' confidence in speaking in front of the class or retelling a story. Therefore, literacy activities are effective in the process of teaching English, especially for speaking ability.
2. The students have to improve their knowledge in learning speaking, especially in speaking. Students are also suggested to be more active, confident, and creative with retell a story, so they be more fluently.
3. The application of literacy activities was proven to be an effective way to influence many students' speaking ability. It is highly recommended for the nest researchers to find out the effectiveness of this activity for improve English language skills.
